1. In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Animal By-Products (Enforcement) (England) Regulations 2011 (as amended)/ Animal By-Products (Enforcement) (No. 2) (Wales) Regulations 2011 and Articles 24 and 44 of Regulation (EC) No. 1069/2009 the Secretary of State/Welsh Ministers approves:

to operate a pet food plant on the premises.

2. All CATEGORY 3 PROCESSED ANIMAL BY-PRODUCTS SHALL BE TREATED FOR AROUND 20 MINUTES AT A MINIMUM OF +90°C IN ONE OF THE PRODUCTION LINES ON THE PREMISES.
3. The pet food shall be sampled at least quarterly each product, AND TESTED FOR SALMONELLA AND ENTEROBACTERIACEAE to verify compliance with the microbiological standards in Chapter II paragraph 5 of Annex XIII of Regulation No. 142/2011.
4. (Not Applicable) Raw petfood manufactured for Category 3 animal by-products shall be sampled as follows:
- Operators handling **tripe, turkey and/or chicken** products are required to take a representative sample of petfood from each of those species (or a representative product type) once a month and submit it for testing for *Salmonella* and *Enterobacteriaceae* at a laboratory accredited by UKAS
 - Operators handling **lamb, beef and/or rabbit** products are required to take a representative sample of petfood from each of those species (or a representative product type) quarterly and submit it for testing for *Salmonella* and *Enterobacteriaceae* at a laboratory accredited by UKAS.

To verify compliance with the microbiological standards in Chapter II paragraph 6 of Annex XIII of Regulation No. 142/2011.
